#### 8. Department of Orthodontics & Dentofacial Orthopedics

Orthodontics is the area of dentistry concerned with the supervision, guidance and correction of the growing and mature dento-facial structure, including those conditions that require movement of teeth or correction of mal relationships and malformations of related structures by the adjustment of relationships between and among teeth and facial bones by the application of forces and/or the stimulation and redirection of the functional forces within the craniofacial complex.

#### 9. Department of Oral Pathology

Oral pathology is that part of pathology and a branch of dentistry concerned with the scientific study of the causes and effects of oral disease and understanding of which are essential for diagnosis and for the development of rational treatment and preventive programmes.

One of the most important purposes of Oral pathology is to give the student the ability to correctly diagnose oral lesions. There are more than 200 different types of diseases that affect the oral cavity & many of these can only be diagnosed through microscopic examination.

The Clinical appearance and history of oral lesions, however can often give the clinician a reliable provisional diagnosis on which he/she can plan further management of the patient. Oral diagnosis is based on sound knowledge of oral pathology and is essential for good clinical practice.

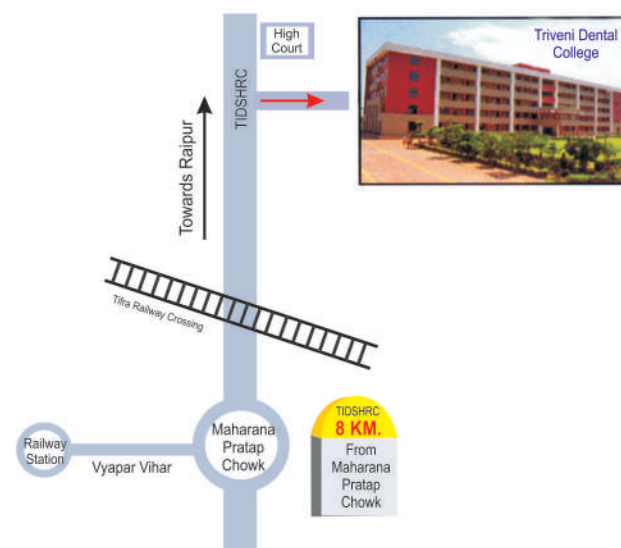

It is my profound desire and ardent endeavour to evolve an educational process involving modern technology and knowledge with preservation of our cultural heritage.

### 1. Department Of Oral Medicine and Radiology

The department of Oral Medicine & Radiology is the first department where the patient visits in any dental institution. Based on history & radiographic examination, patients are diagnosed, referred to & even treated with non surgical line of treatment for various orofacial disorders.

Oral medicine is that area of special competence concerned with the health of and with disease involving the oral and para oral structures. It includes those principles of medicine that relate to the mouth, as well as research in biological, pathological and clinical spheres. Oral Medicine includes the diagnosis and medical management of diseases specific to the orofacial tissues and of oral manifestation of systemic diseases. It further includes the management of behavioral disorders and the oral and dental treatment of medically compromised patients.



### 2. Department of Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery

Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery is a branch that deals with the art of diagnosis and treatment of various diseases, pathologies and defects involving the oro-facial region. This specialty has evolved through the ages and presently the oral & maxillofacial surgeon deals with the various craniofacial pathologies in a multi disciplinary environment.

The department of Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery renders all varieties of surgical treatment ranging from acquired, congenital, traumatic and developmental diseases of the jaws and face to simple extraction of teeth.

The section of oral & maxillofacial surgery has a varied scope. The under graduate program basically deals with knowledge of local anaesthesia, extraction of teeth (exodontia), complications arising thereof and the subsequent management of medical emergencies on the dental chair. Various research projects are also assigned to the students, in order to sensitize them on research methodology etc.



### 3. Department of periodontics



Periodontics is that specialty of dentistry which encompasses the prevention diagnosis and treatment of diseases affecting the supporting and surrounding tissues of the teeth or their substitutes, such as dental implants. The specialty also concerns itself with the maintenance of health, function and esthetics of these structures and tissues.

The Section of Periodontics has a wide range of activities covering all aspects of Periodontics, bone regeneration and surgical implant procedures, Research is a core activity of the section with many contributions that have developed in platelet Rich Plasma, Biochemistry of Gingival Crevicular Fluid, advanced diagnostic aids and surgical techniques for bone regeneration around teeth, alveolar bone and dental implants. As well as there are ongoing research projects focused on the role of bacteria in the development of periodontal disease and studies in the Epidemiology, Immunology and Systemic diseases involvement in periodontal disease.

### 4. Department of Conservative Dentistry & Endodontics

Primary goal of Department of Conservative Dentistry & Endodontics encompasses the diagnosis and treatment of sequelae of dental caries and includes the techniques and procedures to restore the teeth to full function & appearance in an aesthetically pleasing manner with as little loss of healthy tooth structure as possible. It also involves performing root canal treatment and associated surgical procedures to rid the tooth of its offending malady. The treatment provided include surgical endodontics, endodontic implants bleaching, & management of traumatized teeth.

Conservative Dentistry is the branch of dentistry which is concerned with the conservation of teeth in the mouth. It embraces the practice of operative dentistry and endodontics, and includes various kinds of direct and indirect restorations of individual teeth in the mouth. It caters to all forms of patient needs ranging from simple restorations to Endodontic surgeries and Esthetic dentistry. Adequate facilities for carrying out these procedures are made available. The Department houses modern dental units/chairs and a laboratory with casting facilities.

The Department has eminent, dedicated and competent staff carrying out, education and treatment programmes. They actively participate in conferences, workshops and seminars. A number of scientific research and papers have been presented.



### 5. Department of Prosthodontics and Crown and Bridge

Prosthodontics is that of Dentistry pertaining to the restoration & maintenance of oral function, comfort appearance & health of the patient by the restoration of natural Teeth and or replacement of missing teeth & craniofacial tissue with artificial substitutes.

### 6. Department of Preventive and Community Dentistry

Community Dentistry is a branch of Dentistry which deals with preventing disease prolonging life & promoting physical & mental efficiency through organized community efforts for the sanitation of the environment, the control of communicable infections, the education of individual in personal hygiene, the organization of medical & nursing services for the early diagnosis & preventive treatment of disease and the development of the social machinery to ensure everyone a standard of living adequate for the maintenance of the health. It is a department that believes in "Prevention is better than cure" Emphasis on this is increased by spreading this message to masses by means of well-organized school and Community Dental Health Education programmes.

### 7. Department of Pedodontics and Preventive Dentistry

Pedodontics is an age defined specialty that provides primary and comprehensive, Preventive and Therapeutic oral health care for infants and children through adolescence including those with special health care needs.

The implicit in the philosophy of children's dentistry is a commitment to consider the child's feelings, to gain the child's confidence and co-operation to perform the treatment in kind and sympathetic manner, to be concerned with not only providing the treatment currently required but also promoting child's future dental health by stimulating the attitude and behavior regarding dental care.
